Feministattac Workshop

(Austria, Germany, France, Morocco, Italy, Switzerland)

Attac activities and communications must contain the following standards:

- an equal representation of women
- room for women's visions and experiences, as well as current results of feminist research
- gender mainstreaming as an instrument to include feminist thoughts

In the planned Attac-EU-booklet feminist analysis and perspectives are missing. We insist they should be included. This inclusion of feminist thoughts is not only a responsibility of Feminist Attac.

2. Feminist Europe

The EU has to become a Union which puts gender equality at the core of its policies. Either the realization of gender equality is at the core of a social, ecological, solidary, peaceful and democratic Europe or it remains unsustainable piecemeal. The European ATTACs demand:

Equal distribution of wealth and income between women and men.

A true equality between women and men will never be reached without an equal division of domestic work and care (for children, elderly etc.). This needs not only and immediately public services for childcare and other forms of care, but also ambitious alternative employment politics: Access of all women to salaried full-time work, accompanied by a considerable decrease of working hours for all.

Upward harmonization of all social rights of women.

Enforceable fundamental rights must include the right to freedom of sexual violence and state protection from sexual violence, right of state protection from discrimination based on sex, the fundamental right for women to participate equally in the political, social, cultural, civil or any other field.

Adequate participation of women in decision making, e.g. 50% women within European Commission, European Parliament, European Court of Justice, Council, European Central Bank.

High quality public services.

Ensure at the European level that national tax systems do not discriminate against women.
